Treasurer's Report December 2024

1) DISBURSEMENTS for the period October & November 2024

a) I propose that the committee approves these disbursements.

2) BENDIGO BANK

- a) **TOTAL CASH ASSETS \$ 40,450.48 less known commitments \$8-9,000** (Xmas lunch, Bonanza Road building) decrease from last meeting.
- b) Transaction account as at Saturday 30th November \$17,837.81
- c) **Term deposits \$22,512.67** As they mature, we will look at best interest rate options.
 - i) Increasing each by \$1,000 as each matures another 14th Feb 2025.
 - ii) Interest rate expectations vary presently. Bendigo currently quotes 4.5% for 12 months; 3.3% for 24 months for deposits over \$5000. Pundits cite the prospect of increasing inflation in the USA as reason for caution, other believing USA growth will increase in real terms and inflation reducing.
 - iii) (MYOB 1-1113) \$6,169.61 due 12th Aug 2025 @ 4.75%;
 - iv) (MYOB 1-1114) \$5,105.08 due 12th April 2025 @4.75%;
 - v) (MYOB 1-1115) \$5,000.00 due 12th October 2024; I propose rolling this \$ 5,237.50 for 12 months plus \$1,000 @4.6%pa; Bendigo Bank has corrected the discrepancy on the account.
 - vi) (MYOB 1-1116) \$5,000 due 14th Feb 2025; I would propose then rolling this \$ 5,237.50 for 12 months if rates OK..
- 3) XERO conversion is underway. Currently running both MYOB and Xero until total familiarity reached. Having individuals with an email address to lodge reimbursement claims was going to be too expensive at \$5 per month each registered person, plus a higher plan as each receipt is counted as a "invoice/bill" and our plan has a maximum of 5 per month. Just the Bunnings BBQ payments amounted to 15 "bills".
 - a) Costs are
 - i) \$35 in November, paid
 - ii) December to May 2025 \$3.50 for 6 months (90% off \$35 for 6 months incentive), (\$100 on Debit card)
 - iii) then \$26.25 pm thereafter (25% off \$35 as a charity/NFP)
- 4) Other significant updates
 - **Bunnings BBQ** 22nd November: Collections \$1,474.75 Costs \$498.69 **Profit \$976.06** noting these costs include at least \$80 drinks toward our next function.
 - \$3,000 grant has been received from the Bendigo Community Bak in Sandringham.
 - Christmas luncheon Collections \$2380 Deposit \$650 Est. balance \$4,300 Subsidy \$2,570
 - **Cash Box** sign in monies monitoring indicates unders and overs to written records, but happy with the results.

- 1. There was a problem with large table saw which was tripping the circuit breaker. Alan finally traced problem to be in the 3 point plug which was replaced.
- 2. We had a serious problem with the large bandsaw in as much as it had been used to cut some plastic /acrylic material. This caused significant amount of molten material to be deposited on driving wheels causing the tracking to be erratic. New tyres ordered and fitted with new blade which lasted all of 2 days!! Notices have been put on both Bandsaws to limit their use to wood only.
- 3. The table router motor was reported to be fluctuating erratically in speed. This is now being dealt with and establishing if still under warranty for repair or replacement. TBC.
- 4. A good deal of investigation and research has been carried out regarding the purchase of a CNC machine.
